Ernie Crey, author of "The Children of Tomorrow's Great Potlatch" in BC Studies Special Issue In Celebration of Our Survival: The First Nations of British Columbia (No. 89, Spring 1991, pp. 150-158) wishes readers of the journal to know that that the reference to Salish elder Henry Castle (pp. 152-153) and the quotation (p. 153) from Celia Haig-Brown, Resistance and Renewal: Surviving the Indian Residential School (Vancouver: Tillacum, 1988) are in error. Henry Castle was not himself punished in the manner specified, but was commenting on others who were. And the Haig-Brown book did not report his testimony, but that of Randy Fred, who corroborated stories such as his.

BC Studies apologizes to Mr. Crey and to its readers for any misunderstanding these errors may have caused.
